



Active Shooter (LE/MIL)

\$350 Per Student

This 2 day live fire active shooter response course is designed for all first responders alike from patrol officers, tactical officers, SWAT and any other responding law enforcement personnel to an active shooter incident. The premise of the course is to teach all responding officers weapon safety and manipulation while responding to an active shooter incident, teach current tactical industry standards in responding to active shooter incidents. Once these skills are will honed, the live fire application is introduced on the range. The law enforcement student will respond to multiple active shooter scenarios individually, with a partner and then with a 3 to 5 officer response applying the proper tactics, techniques and procedures while engaging shoot / no shoot targets to ensure proper target discrimination and weapon safety in the live fire application.

Ammunition Requirements:

300 rounds rifle
100 rounds pistol

Equipment Requirements:

- Pistol with 3 magazines
- Carbine with 3 magazines (optional)
- Handheld flashlight (weapon light recommended)
- Duty belt holster with magazine pouches
- Body armor
- Knee and elbow protection
- Wrap around ballistic eye wear
- Hearing protection
- Baseball type cap with brim
- Hydration system
- Shooting gloves
- Any equipment normally worn on duty
