

3-Day Precision Rifle (LE)

The course are designed to familiarize the attendee, whether basic or advanced level department snipers, in the use and capabilities of the long range precision rifle, related equipment and to be able to effectively engage stationary targets out to 600 yards.

The course of instruction will additionally address precision firearms maintenance, marksmanship, scope adjustments, range estimation, sniper team communication, mil dot usage, external ballistics, data book and stress shooting.

It is also designed to expand the tactics and procedures addressed to the practical application that may be encountered in a Law Enforcement callout. Subject matter covered will include shooting supported positions other than prone, 300 yards, urban hides/live fire engagements and shooting through assorted glass.

Equipment Required:

- Tactical precision rifle (capable of sub-minute of angle accuracy)
- Scope with target turrets 1/4 minute adjustments, mil-dot reticle preferred
- Rifle mounted bi-pod
- Sling
- Shooting mat
- Spotting scope with stand
- Small calculator
- Small clipboard
- Knee and elbow pads
- Small sand/bean bag for butt stock support
- Shooting sticks (ex. Stoney Point T3T38 portable tripod)
- Rifle cleaning kit
- Ear protection
- Eye protection
- Data book
- Notebook and pencils (pens will not write in rain)
- Tactical uniforms encouraged
